DELAWARE TOWER

The COACB is moving forward with plans to increase the height of a tower it owns on Horseshoe Road in Delaware. This 170 feet high tower and 2.5 acres of land were purchased from Verizon in July 2004. In March 2005, the Federal Aviation Administration gave approval for the COACB to increase the height of this tower to 300 feet. This is extremely important because in November, the FCC announced plans to give class A television stations a second channel to use for digital. The COACB leases space on the Delaware Radio Tower for WXCB TV42. That tower is already loaded to its limit and can not support another transmitting antenna and without this second antenna, the COACB can not put on the digital channel. There are also no other towers in the Delaware area that are suitable.

The cost to increase the height of the tower is expected to be \$20,000. This includes \$3,000 engineering, \$3,000 legal and \$14,000 for the actual addition. GRILLED CHICKEN CAESAR SALAD

8 cups torn romaine lettuce; 1 lb. boneless skinless chicken breast, grilled, cut into strips; 1 cup seasoned croutons; ½ cup Kraft shredded or 100% Grated Parmesan Cheese; ¾ cup Kraft Caesar Italian Fat Free Dressing.

STUDIO A PROJECT

Every time TBN has a Telethon, the COACB uses that time to make major improvements at its stations. During the April telethon, the project chosen was a redo the Studio A control room in Marion. There was a taping scheduled for 6:00 PM on April 4th, so it was decided that the modification could not begin until 9:00 AM on March 5th and the studio must be operational at 6:00 PM on March 11. That was just 6 days to remove all the equipment, build and install the cabinets, monitors, equipment and hook everything back up. Many new improvements had been in planning for months. Some only existed as ideas and plans on scraps of paper and in the minds of the workers.



On April 5th, the crew started the day with prayer; I then left to pick up supplies for the project. Jonathan did an FCC filing that was due. Laura handled the phones and office work. Stacy Yeager, Mark Butler, and Dean Bentley started removing the equipment from the room. We had now passed the point of no return. The entire first day was spent unwiring the current studio and moving all the equipment to a safe place. Only after everything was removed was it possible to know just how much space we had to work with. Not everyone that saw the results of the first day's labor was impressed. One person looked in and asked, "Whose bright idea was this?"

By the time the table top was covered with Formica, the fumes from the glue had just about put all the workers in orbit. This had becoming a-learn-as-you-go-project and we had several setbacks. The design for the monitor assembly was redone about three times before it fit correctly. We really thank Stephen Aiken for his advice on this portion of the project. It also took three tries to cut and drill the Plexiglas shield needed to protect the tiny LCD monitors. When the monitor panel was operational, Stacy Yeager and Dean Bentley were proud as peacocks showing off their handywork to all who came by to check on the progress of the project. Jonathan Aiken was also starting to get pretty good at using a soldering iron to hook up the sub assemblies and Greg Stephens would come after work to help anywhere he could.

After the third day the room was starting to look like a studio again. It was not operational but at least it looked like a studio control room. The studio uses robotic controls for its cameras so there were hundreds of wires to reconnect. Also as you can imagine there was a lot clean up to do with the tear out and reconstruction. Betty Syck really did a wonderful job on this task and kept praising the crews on their progress.



On Friday the crew was starting to make some of the sub systems operational. Quitting time arrived and so much was left to do. Dean Bentley volunteered to meet me after 6:00 PM and would stay with me while I reconnected those hundreds of wires. Dean is recovering from shoulder surgery and can not lift, climb or get down but he could sure push buttons and help route wires to their correct destination. Gary Ruhl arrived and worked with Dean and I until 10:30 PM. We made a lot of headway.

Saturday, just two days to go and so much work to do. My wife, Carolyn, knew that we were in real trouble and offered to help. She ended up working until 11:30 PM Saturday night. **Now she is one very caring wife.** When we left the most basic systems were operational.

Sunday afternoon Dean and I continued the work.

Monday morning, Rick Stevens, Richard Penhorwood, and Curtis Abbott arrived from the Delaware Station to help. We had prayer and then divided up the remaining work giving portions to Rick, Richard, Curtis, Stacy, Jonathan, and I. By 5:00 everything was operational except the zoom controls and camera lifts. Gerald Moore said he could work around those two problems and the Live Program Hymn Time went out from Studio A on schedule. Our people had done the impossible. Studio A control room had been replaced in just six days. Five nights later the Saturday Night Gospel sing went out live from this studio and Paul Walters, the control room operator for that program, was telling everyone that the new control room was a dream to operate.
