The transmitter quit again before they got back to Marion so a trip was planned up the tower on Wednesday, to find the problem.

On Wednesday David and Greg went to the platform at 700 feet up the tower. They discovered that the modulator had failed on the TV-8 transmitter. The modulator was removed and they came down from the tower and started to try to find a replacement.

Gary Cope located a modulator in California and arranged for next day delivery. Thursday arrived and Gary received a call that the package had missed the truck and would be shipped on Thursday for delivery on Friday. Friday arrived and no package. Gary received another call. There had been a mistake and the package went to the wrong city. It had been rerouted and should arrive in Columbus on Monday October 24. The newsletter must go to press before the part arrives so hopefully we will have the transmitter back on the air before you read this article. ### CINNAMON APPLE SPICE CAKE

THELMA AIKEN

1 – 14 to 14 ½ ounce jar of spiced apple rings; 2 cups all purpose flour; 1½ teaspoon baking powder; 1 teaspoon cinnamon; ½ teaspoon salt; ½ teaspoon baking soda; ½ cup butter (softened); 1¼ cups sugar; 1 teaspoon vanilla; 3 eggs; ¾ cup buttermilk.

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease and lightly flour two 8 x 8 x 2 inch square baking pans or two 9 x 1½ inch round cake pans. Set aside. Drain apple rings, and discard syrup. Place apple rings in a blender, cover and process until almost smooth. Should have ¾ cup. Set aside. Stir together flour, baking powder, cinnamon, salt, soda and set aside. In a bowl beat butter, medium to high speed for 30 seconds. Add sugar and vanilla, beating well. Add eggs one at a time, beat well. Add dry mixture and buttermilk alternately. Fold in processed apples. Divide batter equally in 2 prepared pans. Bake 25 to 30 minutes till done. Cool in pans 10 minutes. Remove layers and cool on wire rack till cold. Frost top and sides with Butter Cream Frosting.

#### BUTTER CREAM FROSTING

In a mixing bowl beat ½ cup butter with an electric mixer on medium to high speed until fluffy. Gradually add 3 cups sifted powdered sugar, beating well on low speed. Slowly beat in 1/3 cup milk and 1 teaspoon vanilla. Gradually beat in 3½ cups powdered sugar. If necessary beat in additional milk to make icing easy to spread. Spread between layers, sides and top.

### CRACKER SNACKS

3 packages crackers (unsalted square); 1¼ cup Canola Oil; 1 package dry Ranch Dressing; 1-gallon Zip Lock Bag.

In Zip Lock Bag put your Canola Oil and dry Ranch Dressing and mix until blended. Add your crackers and shake until well coated. Store in a fresh Zip Lock Bag.

### COLD VEGETABLE DISH

1 basket cherry tomatoes; 1 bunch broccoli, fresh and cut up; 1 head cauliflower, fresh and cut up; 1 – 8 oz bottle Italian salad dressing; Mix above ingredients the day before you are ready to serve. Serve cold. Serves 8-10

### CRESCENT TACO PIE

1 pound ground beef; 1 package taco seasoning mix; ½ cup water; 1 can crescent dinner rolls; 1½ cups corn chips, crushed; 1 cup sour cream; 1 cup cheddar cheese, shredded.

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Brown ground beef and drain. Stir in seasoning mix and water. Simmer for 5 minutes. Separate crescent dough into 8 triangles and press into ungreased pie pan to form a pie crust. Sprinkle 1 cup corn chips over bottom of crust. Spoon meat mixture over crust and corn chips. Spread sour cream over meat mixture. Cover with cheese. Sprinkle on remaining corn chips. Bake 20-25 minutes. Serves 4-6.

**COACB TECHNOLOGY**

Ten years ago I read an article where a computer scientist said that if a computer system were ever constructed that had 2 terabytes of online memory, the system would suddenly develop a consciousness of its own self and would start doing independent reasoning. I thought it was an interesting concept, but one that could not be tested because at that time, memory cost \$100 per Meg and to test the theory would require \$200,000,000 for the memory.

Time and technology has moved forward and the COACB now uses a very elaborate computer system that has over 2 terabytes of combined memory online. This was possible because hard drive memory now costs about \$800 per terabyte (1 million meg equals one terabyte).

Although our system hasn't developed a consciousness of its own, we do use it for some amazing feats. The system can automatically capture and store multiple streams of video. It can also edit, and schedule for play over 500 hours of video. Our system can be expanded to send a different program to each COACB transmitters, route video from all COACB studios back to the Video Server and send up to 4 streams of video out of the server at the same time. We have also added a File Transfer Protocol server so programmers can now download video directly to our system from anywhere in the world.

Our high speed Local Area Network is being expanded through the use of microwave links to network Marion, Delaware, Kenton, and Columbus. We are even starting to route telephone calls over the LAN and the internet, so our Columbus phone lines can be answered in Delaware, Marion, or Kenton. We can also video conference and send video Emails from all of the COACB facilities.

Many other features are on the drawing board and will be launched in the near future. These include video on demand, and an internet based television station. We are also working on developing a system that allows engineers in one COACB facility to operate equipment in COACB facilities in other cities without physically going there. As you can see, what was science fiction just a few years ago, is working reality at your COACB stations today.
