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RECIPES

Prime Rib

1 whole rib eye roast	6 T olive oil
4 T tri-color peppercorns	3 sprigs rosemary
3 sprigs Thyme	1/2 c kosher salt
1/2 c minced garlic	

Preheat oven to 500°F. Remove roast from refrigerator and let sit at room temp for 30 min to 1 hour. Cut the rib loin in half (roast halves separately for more controlled/even cooking.) Heat lg skillet over high heat. Add 2 T of oil and sear both halves until they're a nice dark golden color. Place tricolor peppercorns into a bag; use a rolling pin to crush them. Strip leaves from rosemary and thyme springs. Mix salt, crushed peppercorns, rosemary leaves, thyme leaves, and garlic. Pour remaining 4 T of olive oil over rib loin and pour on rub mix. Pat slightly to get it to stick to the meat. Roast for 20 to 30 min, reduce heat to 300°F and roast until a meat thermometer registers 125°F for rare/medium rare, 30 to 50 min. Remove from the oven and let rest at least 20 minutes before slicing.

Cheesy Potato Casserole

1/2 c salted butter	1 chopped yellow onion
2 cloves garlic chopped	16 oz sour cream
2 cans cr of chick soup	8 oz shredded cheddar cheese
1 30 oz bag frozen shredded hash brown potatoes, thawed	
1 c breadcrumbs	1 T chopped parsley

Preheat the oven to 375°. Heat a medium skillet over medium heat. Add 2 tablespoons of the butter, then add the onion. Cook for 5 minutes, then add the garlic. Cook until the onion is slightly softened, about 2 minutes more. Transfer to a plate and let cool slightly. In a large mixing bowl, combine the sour cream, soup, cheese, potatoes, and the onion mixture. Transfer to a greased 3-quart casserole dish. Cover the casserole with foil and bake for 45 minutes. Meanwhile, place the remaining 6 tablespoons of butter in a small bowl. Cover and microwave for 45 to 60 seconds until melted. Mix in the breadcrumbs and parsley. Top the casserole with the breadcrumb mixture and return to the oven, uncovered, until the top is golden brown and the casserole is bubbly all over, 25 to 30 minutes more.
