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Monthly Recipes

Sloppy Joe Casserole

1 T veg. oil	1 lb ground beef
salt/pepper	1 med chop onion
1 chop bell pepper green	1 chop bell pepper red
2 chop cloves garlic	2/3 c ketchup
1 T chili powder	1 t mustard
1 8oz can tomato sauce.	1 c beef broth
2 T apple cider	1 16 oz pkg penne pasta
1 T paprika	2 T brown sugar
1 1/2 c shredded Colby-Jack cheese	

Preheat oven 350 deg. Cook pasta al dente & drain. Brown ground beef, stir in onion, garlic, bell peppers, paprika, salt/pepper. Stir in tomatoe sauce, ketchup, mustard, & brown sugar, bring to a boil, cook till thickened (5min). Remove from heat and stir in pasta and 3/4 c cheese. Coat 9x13 baking pan, transfer mixture to pan and cover with remaining cheese, Bake 20 min.

Tomato Cucumber Salad

1 c halved grape tomatoes	1 c diced cucumber
1/2 c chopped green onion	1/2 c chopped cilantro
1 T lemon juice	1 T chopped mint

Salt and Pepper to taste
Mix everything together in large bowl and chill for 1 hour before serving.

Rainbow Gelatin Squares

4 pkgs (3oz) assorted gelatin flavors, divided
6 env unflavored gelatin 5 3/4 c. boiling water
1 (14oz) can sweetened condensed milk
1/4 c cold water

In sm bowl, combine 1 pkg flavored gelatin & 1 env unflavored gelatin. Stir in 1 c boiling water until dissolved. Pour into 13x9" dish coated with cooking spray. refrigerate until set (20 Min). In another sm bowl combine condensed milk and 1 c boiling water. In another bowl sprinkle 2 env unflavored gelatin over cold water; let stand for 1 min. Stir in 3/4 c boiling water. Add to milk mixture. Spoon 1 c creamy gelatin mixture over first flavored gelatin. Refrigerate until set about 25 min. Repeat from beginning for each color alternating between gelatin and milk. Refrigerate 1 hour after final layer. Cut into 1" squares.
