2024 Fall Auction/Telethon

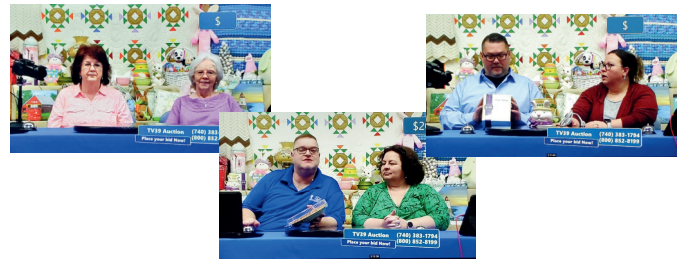

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Monthly Recipe

Apple Crumble

2 lbs sweet tart cooking apples diced
1 T lemon juice
1/2 c white sugar
1/4 t ginger
1 c all-purpose flour
1/4 t baking powder
7 T unsalted butter melted
1 T cornstarch
2 t ground cinnamon
1/2 t allspice
1/2 lb brn sugar
1/4 t kosher salt

Preheat oven 375 deg. Core, peel and dice apples into 1/2" chunks. Combine apples with lemon juice, cornstarch, granulated sugar, 1 1/2 t cinnamon, ginger, and allspice in a lg bowl and toss until well coated. Pour into a round 9" pie pan, 9 x 9" baking dish or 7 x 11" baking dish. Make topping: In med bowl, add flour, brown sugar, remaining 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon, baking powder and kosher salt. Mix together with a fork. Pour in melted butter while mixing with fork until a crumbly mixture forms. Use your fingers to sprinkle the crumbles evenly over the filling. Bake for 45 to 50 minutes until the top is evenly golden brown and the filling is bubbly. Cool for 1 hour, then serve.
