WOCB-CD at Reduced Power



Our TV station in Delaware, Ohio, WOCB-CD, is currently functioning at approximately 70% power. In recent months, we've been addressing power issues, and while we believed we had resolved them, new challenges have arisen.

We previously installed a buck-boost transformer to convert 240V down to 220V, allowing our transmitters to operate more efficiently. However, over time, the transmitter's power supply has failed and needs to be replaced. We have received a quote for the replacement at \$3,000, not including shipping.

Our immediate goal is to order the necessary replacement power supply to restore the station back to full power. Additionally, we aim to rebuild the old power supply to keep as a backup for future issues, ensuring smoother operations in the years ahead.

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Monthly Recipes



Pork Chops & Scalloped Potatoes

3 T butter	3 T all-purpose flour
1-1/2 t salt	1/4 t pepper
14 oz chicken broth	6 loin chops (3/4 inch thick)
2 T canola oil	6 c thinly sliced peeled potatoes
1 med onion, sliced	Paprika and minced fresh parsley

In a small saucepan, melt butter; stir in the flour, salt and pepper until smooth. Add broth. Bring to a boil; cook and stir for 1 minute or until thickened. Remove from the heat and set aside. In a large skillet, brown the pork chops on both sides in oil; sprinkle with additional salt and pepper if desired. In a greased 13x9-in. baking dish, layer potatoes and onion. Pour broth mixture over layers. Place pork chops on top. Cover and bake at 350° for 1 hour; uncover and bake 30 minutes longer or until meat and potatoes are tender. If desired, sprinkle with paprika and parsley.

Dulce de Leche Lava Cakes

Cooking spray	1/3 c. dulce de leche
4 T salted butter	2/3 c. powdered sugar
1 lg egg plus 1 egg yolk	1/2 t vanilla extract
1/4 c. all-purpose flour	Vanilla ice cream, for serving

Preheat the oven to 425°. Spray two 6-ounce ramekins generously with cooking spray and place on a baking sheet. Microwave the dulce de leche and butter in a medium microwave-safe bowl until the butter is melted, about 1 minute. Whisk until smooth. Stir in the powdered sugar until well blended. Whisk in the egg and yolk, then add the vanilla. Stir in the flour. Divide the batter between the prepared ramekins. Bake until the edges of the cakes are firm but the centers are still soft, 11 to 13 minutes. Let stand 1 minute, then run a butter knife around the edges of the cakes and invert onto individual plates while still warm. Sprinkle with powdered sugar and serve with ice cream.
