WHAT IS A "CLASS A" STATION?



Three of our stations, **Wxcb-CD** in Marion, **WGCT-CD** in Columbus, and **WOCB-CD** in Delaware, are designated as Class A television stations by the FCC. A Class A station is a local broadcaster that meets special FCC requirements for community service. This includes producing local programming, meeting children's programming rules, keeping public inspection files, and providing content that genuinely serves the needs and interests of the community. In other words, a Class A station is more than just a signal on the dial... it has a responsibility to its viewers.

Class A stations may also qualify for must-carry rights on cable systems, meaning cable operators can be required to carry the station in its proper local market. This designation recognizes Class A stations as true local voices on the airwaves and helps ensure the community can receive the programming intended for them rather than being replaced or preempted by out-of-market content.

For us, being Class A means ministry, community stories, and local programming have a protected place to be seen and heard. It allows pastors, singers, teachers, and local leaders to share their work and their faith with people right here at home. We consider that not just a legal designation, but part of our mission.

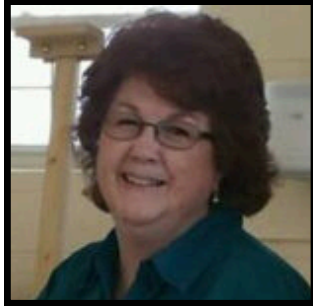

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Kingdom Builder Spotlight

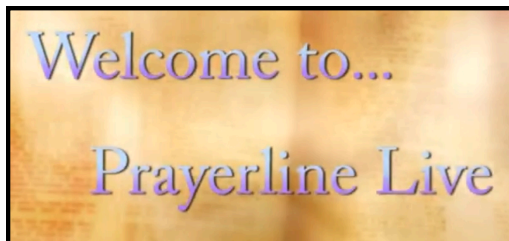

Recipes

Blueberry Cheesecake Breakfast Bars

2 cups old-fashioned oats
1 cup almond flour
1/2 cup coconut oil, melted
1/4 cup honey
1 tsp vanilla extract
8 oz cream cheese, softened
1/4 cup sugar
1 egg
1 cup fresh blueberries

Instructions:

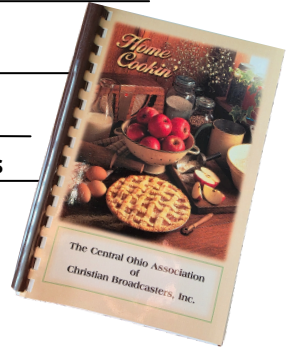
1. Preheat the oven to 350°F and line a 9x9 inch baking dish with parchment paper.
2. In a large bowl, mix together the oats, almond flour, coconut oil, honey, and vanilla extract until well combined.
3. Press half of the oat mixture into the bottom of the prepared baking dish to form the crust.
4. In a separate bowl, beat the cream cheese, sugar, and egg together until smooth.
5. Spread the cream cheese mixture over the oat crust, then sprinkle the blueberries on top.
6. Crumble the remaining oat mixture over the blueberries.
7. Bake for 25-30 minutes, or until the top is golden brown and the cheesecake is set.
8. Allow to cool before cutting into bars and serving.

Fruit Salad

8oz container Cool Whip
3-ounce package instant pistachio pudding mix
20-ounce can crushed pineapple and juice
1 cup miniature marshmallows
1/2 cup finely chopped nuts (walnuts, filberts, or almonds)

Instructions:

Mix all ingredients together and let set for 2 hours or overnight in the refrigerator.
