It's Revival Time!

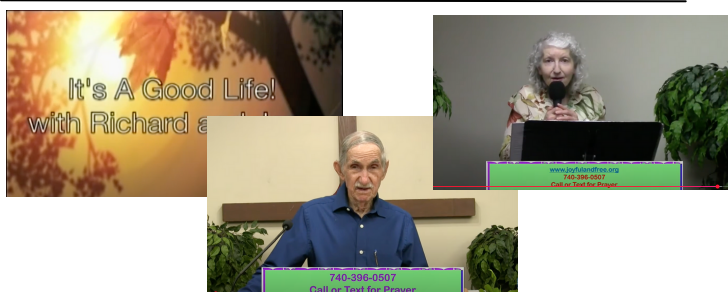

Hawaiian Chicken Skewers

1/2 c barbecue sauce 1/3 c soy sauce
1 T rice wine vinegar 2 t sesame oil
2 cloves garlic, minced 1 T ginger, minced
1 t honey kosher salt
1 t crshd rd pep flks 2 chicken breast, cut 1" pieces
2 c cubed pineapple 2 green bell peppers, diced
1 red onion, diced 2 t cilantro
Preheat grill med heat. In lg bowl, whisk bbq sauce, soy sauce, vinegar, oil, garlic, ginger and honey until combined. Season with salt and red pepper flakes. Build skewers alternating chicken, pineapple, peppers, and red onion. Place on baking sheet and cover with half marinade. Cook 5 min flip, then marinade other side as well. Cook 5 min, or until the chicken is cooked through. Serve with white rice and a sprinkle of cilantro.

Tuscan Tortellini Salad

1 lb. fresh cheese tortellini 1/4 cup extra-virgin olive oil
2 T balsamic vinegar. 1/2 T honey
kosher salt Freshly ground black pepper
3/4 c chopped salami 1/2 c baby spinach
1/2 c oil-pkd sun-dried tomatoes, chopped
1/4 c freshly grated Parmesan
In a lg pot of salted boiling water, cook tortellini according to package directions. Drain and transfer to lg bowl. In a med bowl, whisk together olive oil, balsamic vinegar and honey and season with salt and pepper. Add salami, spinach, sun-dried tomatoes and dressing and toss until well combined. Top with Parmesan.
