RECIPES

Irish Shepherds Pie

3/4 lb peeled potatoes qtrd. 8 oz parsnips peeled cut 1" pcs
8 springs fresh thyme 2 T unsalted butter room temp
2 T olive oil 1 lg onion chopped
3 med carrots peeled 1/4" 2 cloves garlic, pressed
1 lb lean ground lamb/beef. 3 T tomato paste
1/4 t cinnamon 1/2 c beef broth
1/2 t beef bouillon 1/2 c flat leaf parsley chopped

In med saucepan combine potatoes, parsnips, & thyme. Cover w/ cold water bring to a boil. Add 2 t salt, simmer until tender. Keep 1/2 c cooking water, drain veg & discard thyme. Return veg to pot & mash with butter, add 2 T cooking water at a time until smooth. Heat oil in 10" cast iron skillet on med. Add onion cook 3 min. Add carrots cook till tender. Stir in garlic, meat cook till meat done. Stir in tomato paste, cinnamon, 1/2 t ea salt/pepper, cook 1 min. Stir in broth & bouillon, simmer until thickens slightly, fold in parsley. Spread potatoes over mixture & sprinkle with additional thyme. Broil till browned 2-4 min.

Mini Grasshopper Pies

1/4 c whole milk 1 1/2 c marshmallow cream
2 T Unsalted butter cut sm pcs 3/4 c heavy cream
2 T heavy cream 1 1/2 t peppermint extract
1 t pure vanilla extract 12 oreos roughly chopped

melted drk chocolate to drizzle over the top

In med saucepan, heat milk on med until steaming, add marshmallow cream & butter, whisk to melt. Remove from heat and stir in 2 T heavy cream, both extracts, and green food coloring. Transfer to medium bowl, cover and refrigerate until no longer warm to the touch, 40 to 45 minutes. Line 12-cup muffin pan with cupcake liners and divide chopped cookies among liners. Once marshmallow mixture is cool, using stand mixer fitted with whisk attachment, beat remaining 3/4 cup heavy cream on med-high until stiff peaks form, 2 to 3 minutes. Fold a large spoonful of whipped cream into marshmallow mixture until no streaks remain, then fold in remaining whipped cream until combined. Dollop cream mixture into prepared liners and smooth tops. Freeze until set, 1 1/2 to 2 hours. When ready to serve, drizzle pies with dark chocolate and top with crumbled cookies if desired. Pies are best served chilled (they will melt as they sit out).
