RECIPES

Shannon's Green Chicken Tacos

1 15oz jar Herdez Green Salsa 1 pkg corn tortillas
3 lb cooked rotisserie chicken shredded
1 pkg Pico de Gallo med fresh
1 12 oz pkg Mexican shredded cheese
Sour cream & guacamole
Heat chicken in skillet with green salsa. Heat tortillas in microwave wrapped in paper towels for 1 min. Add chicken to tortilla and top with your favorite toppings.

Flan

1 cup white sugar 3 large eggs
1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk
1 (12 fluid ounce) can evaporated milk
1 tablespoon vanilla extract
Preheat oven to 350 deg Melt sugar in a med saucepan over med-low heat till liquefied & golden in color. Carefully pour hot syrup into a deep 9-inch round glass baking dish, turning the dish to evenly coat the bottom; set aside. Beat eggs in lg bowl. Add condensed milk, evaporated milk, and vanilla; beat until smooth. Pour egg mixture on top of caramel in the baking dish; place in a deep roasting pan. Carefully pour in enough hot water to come 1" up sides of dish. Bake in preheated oven till set with a slight jiggle in the center, about 1 hr, checking after 55 minutes. Keep in mind the flan will continue to set as it cools. Remove from oven and carefully transfer baking dish to wire rack; cool to room temp, cover with plastic wrap to prevent a skin forming. Refrigerate for 3 hours or up to 3 days.
