

TRY THESE RECIPES!

PINEAPPLE CHEESE PIE

8 ounces cream cheese; 1 cup heavy cream-whipped;
1/4 cup sugar; 1 and 1/2 cups crushed pineapple-drained;
9 inch graham cracker crust

Whip softened cream cheese and sugar together well. Fold in the whipped cream, and then the well drained pineapple. Spoon into the pie shell. Chill thoroughly, about 2 hours until filling is set.

PRETZEL SALAD

1 cup crushed pretzels; 1/2 cup butter, melted;
1/3 cup sugar; 8 oz. cream cheese; 1/2 cup sugar;
1-2 oz. can crushed pineapple (drained); 8 oz. cool whip

Mix pretzels, butter, and 1/3 cup sugar together; Spread on cookie sheet and roast at 400 degrees for five minutes. Mix together cream cheese and 1/2 cup sugar, then add the pineapple and cool whip. Just before serving, mix in the pretzels.

HEAVENLY WHITE CAKE

2 2/3 cups sifted cake flour; 1 1/2 teaspoon salt;
2/3 cup mazola oil; 3/4 cup water; 2 teaspoons orange extract;
1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar; 1 1/2 cups sugar; 4 teaspoons
baking powder; 4 egg yolks; 1 teaspoon vanilla;
4 egg whites.

Sift flour, sugar and baking powder in small mixing bowl. Make a well and add in order, mazola oil, egg yolks, water and flavoring, beat till smooth. In large bowl, beat cream of tartar with egg whites until stiff. Gently fold first mixture into egg whites. Pour into two 9-inch cake pans, ungreased and line with wax paper. Bake 30 minutes 350degree oven.

FILLING

Make vanilla pudding and spread between layers.

ICING

Melt 10 marshmallows in just enough milk to line bottom of pan, cool slightly, pour into 1/2 pint of heavy whipping cream, beat until stiff. Ice cake and top with coconut.


