Try These Recipes

### APRICOT NECTAR CAKE

THELMA AIKEN

1 box yellow cake mix; 2/3 cup corn oil; 5 eggs; 1 package lemon Jell-O; 2/3 cup apricot nectar.

Mix all together. Beat for several minutes. Bake in greased tube pan in 340 degree oven for 50 to 60 minutes.

#### ICING

1 cup powdered sugar; 1 teaspoon lemon juice; 2 table-spoons apricot nectar.

Mix while cake is still warm. Poke holes in cake, then pour icing over cake and cool in pan.

### OREO DESSERT

20 Oreo Cookies, crushed; 2 boxes (3.4-oz.) instant chocolate pudding mix; 3 cups milk; 1 carton (8-oz.) Cool Whip, thawed.

Reserve a few cookie crumbs to sprinkle on top and pour rest into a 9"x13"x2" dish and spread evenly over bottom. In large bowl, prepare pudding according to package directions using only 3 cups milk. Fold in Cool Whip, then pour over cookie crumbs. Sprinkle with reserved crumbs. Cover with plastic wrap and refrigerate at least 2 hours.

### ROCKY ROAD CANDY

2 (8 oz) bars milk chocolate, cut up; 3 cups tiny marshmallows; 3/4 cups coarsely chopped nuts

In a medium saucepan slowly melt milk chocolate over low heat. Stir in marshmallows and chopped nuts. Spread in a buttered 8" x 8" x 2" pan. Chill until chocolate is firm. Cut into squares. Makes 1 1/2 pounds.



### LAZY CHOCOLATE ICEBOX PIE

Baked pie shell; 20 large marshmallows; 1 - 8 oz almond chocolate bar; 1 - 8 oz carton Cool Whip; Finely chopped pecans (optional)

Melt marshmallows and chocolate over low heat or double boiler. Cool partially and fold in Cool Whip. Sprinkle with pecans if desired. Place in pie shell and chill.

### PEPPERONI ROLLS

Thaw loaf of frozen bread dough. Let rise slightly. Pinch off pieces about the size of walnuts. Put a piece of pepperoni about one inch long and 1/2 inch in diameter in center of dough and pull around it so none of the pepperoni is showing. Bake until dough is done and lightly brown.
