SPRING TELETHON & AUCTION

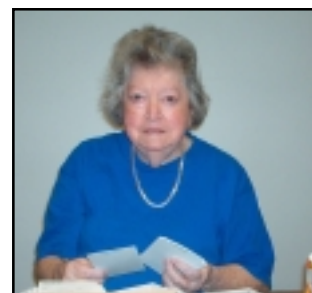

Try These Recipes

DOUBLE BLUEBERRY PIE

1- 9-inch baked pie shell; 1 – 16-ounce jar of blueberry jam; ¼ teaspoon cinnamon; 2 cup fresh blueberries; sweetened whip cream or vanilla ice cream.

Bake and cool pie shell. In a microwave dish combine blueberry jam and cinnamon on high until liquefied about 1 minute. Stir in fresh blueberries and spoon mixture into prepared shell. Chill and serve with whipped cream or vanilla ice cream.

QUICK MICRO-PEANUT BRITTLE

In large bowl, add 1 cup raw Spanish peanuts, 1 cup sugar, ½ cup Karo and dash of salt. Stir until sugar is moistened. Cook in microwave for 10 minutes (stir often) add 1 tablespoon of butter and 1 teaspoon of baking soda. Pour onto greased cookie sheet. Let cool, break into pieces. Delicious!

BUTTERCUP CAKE

2 ¼ Cups flour; 1 ½ Cups sugar; 1 tsp baking powder; ½ tsp soda; 1 tsp salt; ½ Cup shortening; 1 Cup buttermilk; 1 tsp flavoring; ¾ tsp other flavoring

Beat 2 minutes. Add 1 1/3 to 1 ½ cup unbeaten eggs (2 medium). Beat 2 minutes. Bake 30 – 35 minutes at 350°. Use any chocolate or white icing.

The COACB was experimenting at doing Video On Demand using large servers and MPEG-4 files when we learned that Google will now allow anyone to place video on the Google Video Server at www.video.google.com. Broadcasters can now place their programs on the internet and the video can be seen at any time from anywhere in the world. At the present time there is no charge from Google for the service and the videos are available online 24 hours per day. Access to the videos requires a high speed connection of about 250 kbs. Anyone can upload their files to Google themselves. For those needing help, the COACB can provide technicians and equipment to upload videos at our normal hourly rates.
