## TRY THESE RECIPES!

### PIZZA CASSEROLE

Cook 2 cups twisted macaroni. Meanwhile brown 1 pound ground beef, ½ cup chopped onion and ½ teaspoon salt. Mix altogether with 10½ oz. pizza sauce, 12 oz. tomato paste, ½ teaspoon salt, and ½ teaspoon garlic salt. Place one-half mixture in large casserole and top with grated mozzarella cheese and pepperoni slices.

Add remaining mixture and top with more mozzarella cheese and pepperoni slices. Sprinkle with grated parmesan cheese and bake 350 degrees for 45 minutes.

### AMAZING COCONUT CUSTARD PIE

The Secret: It makes its own crust.

Just mix, bake and serve. 2 cups milk; ¾ cup sugar (can use Splenda); ½ cup Bisquick Mix; 4 eggs; ¼ cup oleo or butter; 1½ teaspoon vanilla; 1 cup Baker's Angel Flake Coconut.

Combine milk, sugar, bisquick mix, eggs, oleo or butter and vanilla in electric blender. Cover and blend on low speed for 3 minutes. Pour into lightly greased 9 inch pie pan. Let stand 5 minutes and then sprinkle with the 1 cup coconut. Bake 350 degrees for 4 minutes. Serve warm or cold. It's better served cold.

### WHITE FRUIT CAKE

1 1/2 cups butter or crisco; 2 cups sugar; 2 cups cake flour; 1 tablespoon baking powder; 1 cup milk; 1 teaspoon vanilla; 2 cups flour; 2 cups nuts (chopped fine); 1 pound white seedless raisins; 8 ounce package candied cherries; 8 ounce package candied pineapple; 8 ounce package angel flake coconut; 1 1/2 cups egg whites (room temperature)

Cream butter and sugar well. Sift two cups flour and baking powder, add alternately with milk beating well. To the next two cups of flour add raisins and nuts till well covered with flour. Add to other mixture. Mix well. Add cherries, pineapple and coconut, blending evenly. Beat egg whites till they stand in stiff peaks and fold into the mixture. Pour into an angel food pan, lined with brown paper and greased well and floured. Bake in 325 degree oven one hour, reduce heat to 275 degree and bake for two hours longer till done. Cool in pan, remove, wrap well and store in an airtight place. Age if desired or wrap and freeze.

### DVD FACTORY

The COACB now has a state-of-the-art CD/DVD production system. We can actually say it is a CD/DVD factory. The art work and the disk contents are loaded into the host computer a stack of up to 25 blank disks are loaded. The operator then presses the start button and goes on to other duties. Our tiny factory then does all the tasks of burning the CD or DVD, printing a full color label directly onto the disk and neatly stacking the finished disks. It takes just 3 minutes to make a complete CD and just 18 minutes to make a DVD.

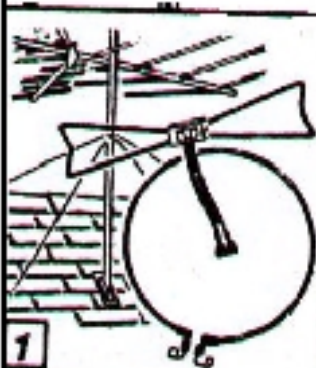

## HOW TO RECEIVE YOUR COACB STATION BY ANTENNA



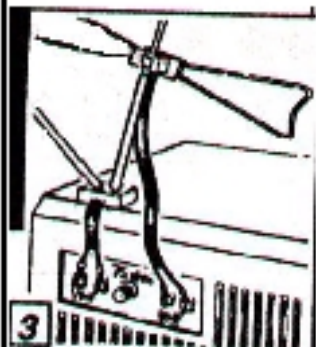
First you need a good UHF antenna. If you are close to the station, an inside antenna may be sufficient, but usually an outside antenna mounted as high as possible works best.

### HELPFUL TIP:

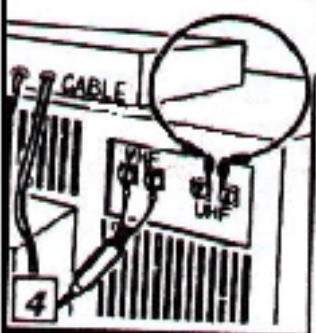
The COACB has made special arrangements with several suppliers to offer antennas at wholesale prices.



If your television has separate VHF and UHF inputs then you will need a splitter. Most modern TVs have only one input and do not require a splitter.



Connect your set as shown if you are using inside antennas to receive both UHF and VHF. Be sure that the UHF antenna is connected to the UHF input. If you have only one input then a combiner must be used to combine the signals from the two antennas.



If your cable company does not carry your COACB station, you can still use the UHF input and an antenna to receive it. If your set has only one input, you will need an A/B switch to switch between cable and antenna.



There are reports from several people that after installing a good outside antenna and booster, that they were able to receive up to 10 stations that their cable system did not carry.

## GOT A DISH???

You can still use an antenna to receive all local channels including your local COACB station.

On the back of Dish and Direct-TV receivers there is an input for a VHF/UHF antenna. Anytime the receiver is turned off, the signal from this input is looped through to the television. Because this is a passive switching circuit there is some loss and may require a signal booster for weak signals.

## NEED AN ANTENNA OR BOOSTER?

The COACB has made a special arrangement with an electronics distributor so viewers can purchase, at wholesale prices, antennas, towers, boosters, or other items required to receive a COACB station.
