## STILL WAITING ON CANADA

**W**e keep hearing from the FCC, it will be any day now; but as we go to press: no word from the Canadians. A treaty between the US and Canada requires that all stations within 150 miles of the Canadian border be coordinated between the two countries. Since both stations are within 150 miles of the border, Canada must sign off on the power increases for WXCBC in Delaware and WOBCB in Marion.

Almost all of the Canadian territory within 150 miles of our stations are located within Lake Erie so the FCC says it is just a formality of having Canada sign their approval.

The COACB is really anxious to increase the power on both stations, but cannot order the new antennas for them until the paperwork arrives. We do have the antenna manufacturer on standby and the antennas will be fabricated within three weeks of our receiving the go ahead from the FCC. The tower crew is also on standby so we expect to proceed with the power increases within a month of receiving approval.

Add potatoes and parsley. Mix well. Pour into slow cooker (I put stuff into crockpot and stir in it). Cover. Cook on low 4 hours. Serve warm or
