We have located two potential towers that seem suitable but we must receive permission from the FCC to use either. Our donations are down which severely limits the amount we can pay for tower rent. WILL CABLE TV LOOK AT CHALLENGES AS OPPORTUNITIES?



1 pound salt pork (all fat); 1 pint boiling water; 4 cups sugar; ½ cup molasses; 1 egg; 1 teaspoon soda; 1 teaspoon nutmeg; 1 teaspoon cinnamon; 1 teaspoon cloves; 1 pound raisins; 6 cups flour.

Put pork through grinder. Pour boiling water over it and let stand till luke warm. Stir in sugar, spices, soda, well beaten eggs and molasses. Sift flour and add to pork mixture. Mix well. Bake 2 hours in well greased pan in 300 degree oven. Especially good for picnics or outdoor meals.

MEXICAN PASTA SALAD

In a large bowl combine the mayonnaise, garlic salt and pepper. Add the pasta, salsa and onion. Toss to coat. May add cubes of cheddar cheese for additional flavor. Cover and chill for one hour.

FILING WINDOW

Since 1998 we have operated TV-48 in Kenton under special temporary authority. There has been no opportunity to file for a permanent channel. The FCC has announced a filing window for next month. We now need \$1,500 for filing fees and engineering. Will you please help with this project? We plan to offer four digital channels on this station.

NEW EQUIPMENT INSTALLED

The COACB now broadcasts four program channels on Marion and Delaware stations. We have now installed the equipment to broadcast local programming on each of those channels. Cable systems currently carry the .1 channel but do not currently carry the .2, .3, and the .4 channels. For that reason we are offering very special program rates on channels .2-.4 for Churches than want a TV ministry but have but have limited funds. These special rates are for ready to broadcast programs and do not include any production services.
