WHAT IS THE COACB?

Today's edition of The Christian Broadcaster Newsletter is being delivered to 8,000 new homes so for our many new readers, let me give you a little information about the COACB.

In 1980 the Central Ohio Association of Christian Broadcasters (COACB) was organized for the purpose of spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ through the means of radio and television stations.

In 1988, it was granted a license for W39AQ (WOCB-CA), Marion, Ohio. The station signed on the air on June 14, 1989 with an effective radiated power of 560 watts. What the station lacked in power, it made up for in enthusiasm. In 1992, the FCC granted permission for the station to increase its power to 18,900 watts.

Plans for a new broadcast complex were drafted in 1995, and the complex was completed in April 1996 and is located at 1282 N. Main Street in Marion, Ohio. This 9,000 sq. ft. facility houses the corporate offices and main studios of the Central Ohio Association of Christian Broadcasters.

The organization purchased W56CA (WXCB-LP), Delaware, Ohio, in February 1997. Offices and studios for WXCB-CA are located at 36 Spring Street in Delaware Ohio.

In 1998, the COACB built WOCB-CA which is authorized as a special temporary authority and carries the same call sign as the Marion station. The permit for this station must be renewed every six months until the FCC sets a filing window and the COACB files for a permanent license for this station. Studios are located at 14 N. Main Street in Kenton, Ohio.

In January 2006, the COACB purchased WGCT-CA in Columbus Ohio. The COACB has applied to the FCC for permission to increase the power of WGCT-CA by 32 times. Currently, WGCT-CA and WXCB-CA share offices, staff, and studios from the Delaware facility.

The organization is recognized by the IRS as a type 501c3 organization and donations to it are tax deductible. Donations are accepted to further the cause of spreading the gospel.

1 cup butter; 1 cup sugar; 2 eggs; 2 teaspoons vanilla; 3 cups flour; ¼ teaspoon salt; colored granulated sugar for rolling.

Brown ground beef, pepper and onion in a skillet. Stir in all other ingredients and bring to a boil. Simmer 10 minutes or longer to desired consistency.

CRANBERRY QUEEN CAKE

Pour batter into a well greased and Floured 10 inch tube pan. Bake in 300 degree oven About 1 hour and 30 minutes or until cake tests done. Cool in pan 10 minutes, take out, cool and ice.

FROSTING

¾ cup jellied cranberry sauce; 1 pound confectioners sugar; ¼ cup butter. Mix well and swirl frosting on sides and top of cake. Sprinkle top of cake with silver dredges.



SPROUTING SEEDS OF FAITH

People ask how the COACB started. My reply is that all great things start with a simple seed. They are bewildered when they consider that our organization which now operates four television stations, four production studios, an intercity relay, and internet web site. All this is geared to reaching over 1,500,000 people and bringing the lost and downhearted to the saving glory of Jesus Christ. This all started from just a very tiny seed of faith.

Our story starts forty years ago, when a young man, David R. Aiken received his draft notice. The Army also made the offer that if David would serve three years, he would be trained in electronics and become a Field Radio Repairman. After receiving training David began serving with the First Maintenance Battalion in Germany. David learned the skills needed to repair anything electronic that the army could transport to the field by plane, semi, helicopter, or by foot. His commander saw potential and sent David to Bavaria for advanced training in solid State Electronics. Little did anyone suspect that God was preparing the seeds for the COACB?



After serving three years in the Army, David was very happy to come home to his longtime sweetheart Carolyn. They married in January 1969. David was soon back into repairing radios and TVs. He learned that the radio station in Galion had a transmitter that need to be rebuilt. The station was new and had no money. David was a new preacher that was experienced in transmitter repair and with a great zeal to spread the gospel. David traded repair services for airtime. Carolyn named his program "The Word of Truth" This is where David officially became "hooked" on broadcasting.

Well radio was wonderful but David kept noticing the power of television. The cost of television was entirely out of reach. Marion CATV said he could broadcast over their system if he would furnish his own equipment. David and Carolyn sought the Lord's help with prayers and tears. Why was the desire to reach out through television so great when there appeared to be no way possible to accomplish this? David just could find any way to acquire the much needed equipment.

Journeying to J.C. Penney's store one day David saw a table full of broken CB Radios with a sign saying "Broken make Offer". David looked them over and decided to buy them all to repair. After repairing the radios he started selling them. They sold like hotcakes one, two, five. Before he knew it he was down to his last two. Just then he met a man who wanted those two base C.B. radios. The man offered to trade a black and white camera and recorder for the two radios. David now had the camera and recorder needed for a television broadcast. This simple Black and White Camera was the start of what we all know as the Central Ohio Association of Christian Broadcasters. Soon churches were asking to borrow the equipment so they

too could have a television broadcast.

The Seeds of Faith had started to sprout. First there was a broadcast, then numerous churches having broadcasts over CATV. Next came the forming of the COACB as a not for profit organization. Later there came the construction of channel 39, the purchase of TV56, the construction of TV48, and the purchase of TV 8. The seed has grown unto a Glorious flower that has reached untold thousands with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. In this we are very thankful but the Lord still speaks that as long as He receives the Glory, there is very much more to come.
