#### ATTENTION COLUMBUS !!!

The COACB is coming! The Canadian government is satisfied. The FCC has given its go ahead. The equipment is ordered, and the tower crew has circled March 20, Yes, it's true, COACB station WXCB in Delaware is also going to serve Columbus, Ohio.

Delivery of the transmitter modification kit is scheduled for February 20. The new antenna will be delivered on March 12. The channel change and power increase can then take place any day. Weather will be the determining factor for the exact date that the change will take place. It must be a clear day with low winds and a temperature of at least 40 degrees.

WXCB will shut down on channel 56, while the transmitter is modified and the antenna changed. It will then sign back on the air on channel 42. These changes will take 24 -72 hours.

Channel 56 operates at 6,500 watts . Channel 42 will operate at 35,000 watts. Even the class of the station will change. It is a Low Power Station but when it changes to channel 42, the station will be a Class "A" Station.

Engineering graphs show that WXCB will give a grade "A" signal down to Worthington, a grade "B" signal over the North half of Columbus and grade "C" signal beyond its southern border.

More changes are coming for WXCB. It will cost \$18,000 to complete this channel change and power increase. WXCB has plans to file for an additional power increase as soon as all the bills associated with this increase are paid.

Be sure to tell all your friends to go out and buy an antenna to receive WXCB.

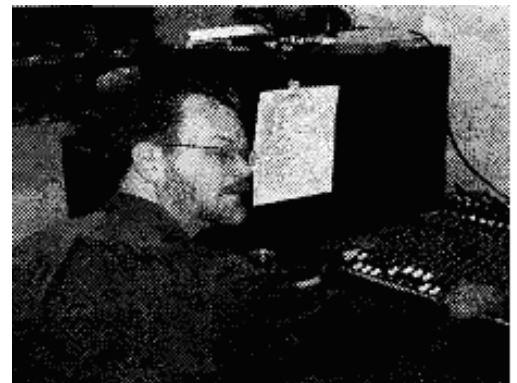

**TRY THESE RECIPES AT HOME!**

**HONEY LAYER CAKE**

2 cups cake flour; 1/4 tsp. salt; 1 tsp. soda; 1/2 tsp. ginger; 1/2 tsp. cinnamon; 1/2 cup shortening; 1 cup honey; 1 egg separated; 2 tablespoons lemon juice or vinegar plus enough milk to make 1/2 cup liquid.

Sift, then measure flour; sift 3 times with salt and spices. Cream shortening, add honey gradually, beating thoroughly. Add dry ingredients alternately with milk mixture. Blend thoroughly. Blend in stiffen beaten egg white. Pour into 2 greased 1-inch cake pans. Bake in 350 degree oven for 30 to 35 minutes. Cool and frost.

**QUICK STRAWBERRY FROSTING**

1 egg white; 1/8 tsp. salt; 1 cup strawberry preserves or any tart jam or jelly; Combine and beat until frosting will stand in peaks. Spread on cake.

**BUTTERMILK PIE**

2 cups sugar; 4 eggs (beaten); 2 tablespoons flour; 3/4 stick (6 tablespoons) margarine, melted; 2/3 cup buttermilk; 1 tablespoon vanilla

Mix ingredients together. Pour into 8" or 9" unbaked pie shell. Bake 50 minutes at 325 degrees. Test with toothpick for doneness.
