TRANSMITTER READY TO SHIP

OUR NEW CHANNEL 45 TRANSMITTER IS READY FOR SHIPMENT TO MARION. WE EXPECT DELIVERY BEFORE NOVEMBER 1. A DECISION WAS MADE TO HOLD UP INSTALLATION OF THE NEW EQUIPMENT UNTIL THE WEEK FOLLOWING TELETHON BECAUSE OUR OPERATING CHANNELS FOR MARION AND DELAWARE WILL BE SWITCHED AND WE WERE AFRAID MANY PEOPLE WOULD HAVE TROUBLE REPROGRAMMING THEIR TELEVISIONS.

ANYONE WATCHING WITH AN ANTENNA WILL HAVE TO RESCAN FOR DIGITAL CHANNELS. ACTUALLY WITH ALL THE NEW DIGITAL CHANNELS BEING ACTIVATED IT IS WISE TO RESCAN FOR CHANNELS EVERY MONTH ANYWAY. PERSONS WITH A GOOD OUTSIDE ANTENNA AND PREAMP CAN EXPECT TO GET CLOSE TO 30 LOCAL DIGITAL CHANNELS. I HAVE AN ANTENNA, ROTOR AND PREAMP AND I GET 49 LOCAL DIGITAL CHANNELS AND MORE ARE COMING ON ALL THE TIME.

FOR PERSONS WATCHING BY CABLE AND INTERNET, THERE IS NOTHING ADDITIONAL THEY NEED TO DO. JUST REMEMBER THAT IF YOU WATCH BY ANTENNA AND SUDDENLY YOU DO NOT GET YOUR COACB STATION, JUST HAVE YOUR TV RESCAN FOR CHANNELS AND THE TV WILL FIND THE NEW CHANNEL ASSIGNMENT AND YOUR COACB STATION WILL BE BACK.

BE SURE TO TELL FRIENDS THAT HAVE OUTSIDE ANTENNAS AND THAT LIVE IN MANSFIELD, CAREY, WILLARD, FINDLAY, MARYSVILLE, SHELBY AND MANY OTHER OHIO CITIES TO SCAN FOR NEWS CHANNELS AND THERE IS A GOOD CHANCE THEY TOO CAN WATCH THE COACB WHEN OUR NEW EQUIPMENT IS INSTALLED.

Free admission. Everyone welcome.

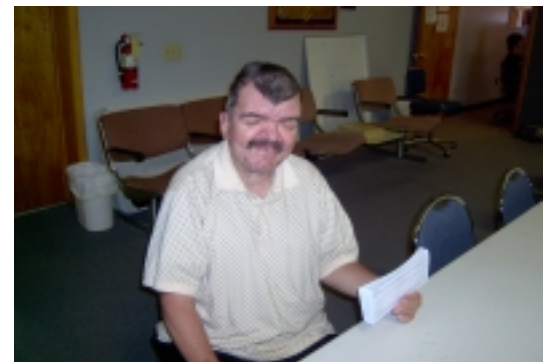
NOVEMBER LOVE GIFT

CINNAMON APPLE SPICE CAKE

THELMA AIKEN

1 – 14 to 14 ½ ounce jar of spiced apple rings; 2 cups all purpose flour; 1½ teaspoon baking powder; 1 teaspoon cinnamon; ½ teaspoon salt; ½ teaspoon baking soda; ½ cup butter (softened); 1¼ cups sugar; 1 teaspoon vanilla; 3 eggs; ¾ cup buttermilk.

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease and lightly flour two 8 x 8 x 2 inch square baking pans or two 9 x 1½ inch round cake pans. Set aside. Drain apple rings, and discard syrup. Place apple rings in a blender, cover and process until almost smooth. Should have ¾ cup. Set aside. Stir together flour, baking powder, cinnamon, salt, soda and set aside. In a bowl beat butter, medium to high speed for 30 seconds. Add sugar and vanilla, beating well. Add eggs one at a time, beat well. Add dry mixture and buttermilk alternately. Fold in processed apples. Divide batter equally in 2 prepared pans. Bake 25 to 30 minutes till done. Cool in pans 10 minutes. Remove layers and cool on wire rack till cold. Frost top and sides with Butter Cream Frosting.

BUTTER CREAM FROSTING

In a mixing bowl beat ½ cup butter with an electric mixer on medium to high speed until fluffy. Gradually add 3 cups sifted powdered sugar, beating well on low speed. Slowly beat in 1/3 cup milk and 1 teaspoon vanilla. Gradually beat in 3½ cups powdered sugar. If necessary beat in additional milk to make icing easy to spread. Spread between layers, sides and top.

CRACKER SNACKS

3 packages crackers (unsalted square); 1¼ cup Canola Oil; 1 package dry Ranch Dressing; 1-gallon Zip Lock Bag.

In Zip Lock Bag put your Canola Oil and dry Ranch Dressing and mix until blended. Add your crackers and shake until well coated. Store in a fresh Zip Lock Bag.

COLD VEGETABLE DISH

1 basket cherry tomatoes; 1 bunch broccoli, fresh and cut up; 1 head cauliflower, fresh and cut up; 1 – 8 oz bottle Italian salad dressing; Mix above ingredients the day before you are ready to serve. Serve cold. Serves 8-10

CRESCENT TACO PIE

1 pound ground beef; 1 package taco seasoning mix; ½ cup water; 1 can crescent dinner rolls; 1½ cups corn chips, crushed; 1 cup sour cream; 1 cup cheddar cheese, shredded.

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Brown ground beef and drain. Stir in seasoning mix and water. Simmer for 5 minutes. Separate crescent dough into 8 triangles and press into ungreased pie pan to form a pie crust. Sprinkle 1 cup corn chips over bottom of crust. Spoon meat mixture over crust and corn chips. Spread sour cream over meat mixture. Cover with cheese. Sprinkle on remaining corn chips. Bake 20-25 minutes. Serves 4-6.

CORN PUDDING

1 can whole kernel corn; 1 can creamed corn; 2 eggs; 1 cup sour cream; 1 box Jiffy corn muffing mix; 1 stick melted butter; salt & pepper; Mix all together. Bake at 350° for 30-45 minutes
