### **Monthly Recipes Marry Me Chicken**

1T virgin olive oil 6 chicken thighs 2 cloves garlic, minced 1T fresh thyme chopped 1 t crushed red pepper 3/4 c chicken broth 1/2 c heavy cream 1/2 c chopped sun dried 1/4 c grated fresh parmesan tomatoes Preheat oven 375 deg. In Ig oven safe skillet over med heat, heat oil. Season chicken with salt & pepper & sear skin side down, until golden, about 4-5 min. Move chicken to plate and pour off half the fat from skillet. Heat garlic, thyme, red pepper flakes, cook till fragrant., 1 min, stir in broth, heavy cream, tomatoes, & parmesan. season with salt. bring to a simmer and return chicken to skillet skin side up. Place in oven bake 17 - 20 min or until chicken is done.

#### **Oven Roasted Root Vegetables**

1 lb sweet potatoes	3/4
1/2 lb beets trimmed	1/2
1 parsnip halved	1/2 r
6 garlic cloves whole	1/4
2 T fresh thyme	5 sp

lb red potatoes lb large carrots halved red onion c virgin olive oil 5 sprigs fresh rosemary 1 t kosher salt

1 t cumin 1/4 t black pepper

Preheat oven 400 deg. Slice all vegetables into bite size chunks. place vegetables in Ig mixing bowl, add 3 T olive oil, thyme, cumin, salt, black pepper. Stir till all vegetables are coated evenly. Brush lg rimmed baking sheet with remaining oil. Spread vegetables evenly across sheet. pan. Roast 15 min then stir vegetables around on pan & roast another 15-25 min or until golden brown.

#### **Chocolate Chunk & Cherry Cookies**

- 1 1/2 c all-purpose flour 1 c cocoa
- 1 t baking soda
- 1 t salt 3/4 c sugar 2 sticks unsalted butter
- 1 1/4 c dark brown sugar 2 lg eggs 2 t vanilla extract
  - 1 1/2 c chopped bitter
- 1 1/2 c dried tart cherries chocolate

Preheat oven 350 deg. Line baking pan with parchment paper and set aside. Combine flour, cocoa, salt & baking soda in med bowl set aside. beat butter & sugars in lg bowl until fluffy. Add 1 egg at a time then add vanilla. On slow mix, gradually add flour mixture. Stir in chocolate & cherries. Shape 2 T batter into balls and place 2" apart on baking sheet. Bake 11-13 min. Cool on pan 2 min then transfer to cooling rack.


