Monthly Recipes

Cornmeal Biscuits Cheddar, Chives, Jalapeno

1/3 c all purpose flour
2 1/2 t baking powder
1 t sugar
6 T unsolted butter
1/4 t baking soda
1 1/4 t salt
3/4 c buttermilk
1 1/2 c grated sharp

chopped cheddar

1/4 c chives thinly sliced

Preheat oven 425 deg. Whisk flour, cornmeal, baking powder, baking soda, sugar and salt in large bowl. Cut in butter until crumbly. Pour in buttermilk until dough comes together. Kneed in cheddar, jalapeno, and chives. Pack 1/4 c measurer with dough and dump onto parchment lined baking sheet. Leave 2" between biscuits. Brush tops with buttermilk. Bake 15 min or until tops are brown.

Christmas Morning Wife Saver

10 slices of bread12 slices of ham2 c grated cheddar6 large eggs1/2 t black pepper1 t dry mustard

1/4 c chopped chives 2 t Worcestershire sauce

1 t hot sauce 3 c whole milk

1/2 c melted butter 1 c corn flake cereal crushed Butter 9x13 baking pan. Cover bottom with 5 slices of bread. Layer ham and cheddar. do another layer of bread, ham, and cheddar. Whisk together eggs, pepper, dry mustard, chives, Worcestershire sauce and hot sauce. Add milk and whisk again. Pour mixture over bread mixture. Cover and refrigerate over night. Next morning prehead oven 350 deg. Pour melted butter over mixtue and cover with corn flakes. Bake for 1 hour or until lightly browned. Let set 10 min.

Christmas Jell-O Trifle

1 pk prepared orange Jell-O 1 pk prepared red Jell-O 1 pk prepared green Jell-O 1 can crushed pineapple Sm whipped cream drained

Frozen orange juice thawed 1 pk prepared vanilla

2 pound cakes sliced thin pudding

1 pk unflavored gelatin

Mix unflavored gelatin with frozen orange juice. In large sq container make in layers. Pound cake, drizzle with vanilla pudding, drizzle with orange juice, spread some pineapple around, put drops of each Jell-O and whipped cream. Start new layer and continue till everything is used
