Finding Freedom in Christ



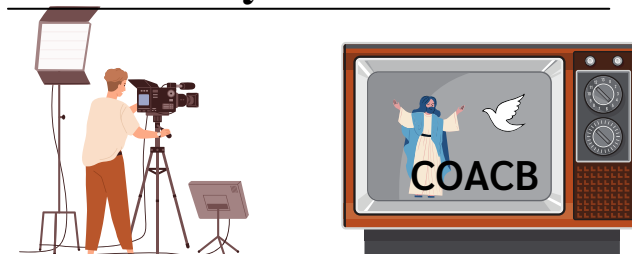

COACB Members Hit The Fair

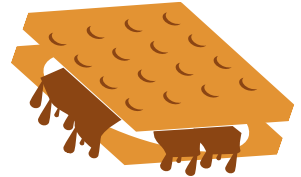

Monthly Recipes



Jalapeno-Garlic-Onion Cheeseburgers

1 fresh chopped jalapeno 2 cloves garlic minced
1 small onion chopped 1 lb lean ground beef
4 slices pepper jack cheese 4 hamburger buns toasted
Preheat grill to high heat. Mix jalapeno, garlic, onion, and ground beef in med bowl. Form into four patties. Brush grill grates with oil. Grill hamburger patties 5 min per side or until at your desired doneness. Add pepper jack cheese. Serve on Bun with your favorite condiments.

Buttermilk Potato Salad

2 lbs baby potatoes quartered 1/4 c Miricle Whip
1/4 c sour cream 1/4 buttermilk
1/4 c chopped fresh chives 1 T minced garlic
1 c. shredded cheddar cheese 10 slices cooked bacon
Boil potatoes in large pot in salted water for about 15 minutes or till tender. Drain. Combine Miricle Whip, sour cream, buttermilk, chives, & garlic in lg bowl. Add potatoes & cheddar cheese, mix well, chill 2 1/2 hours. Top with crumbled bacon before serving.

S'mores Icebox Cake

1 1/2 c heavy cream 1 c marshmallow cream
16 graham crackers 2 c chocolate pudding
1/2 c mini marshmallows Melted dark chocolate
Prepare chocolate pudding according to package and chill. Beat on high heavy cream & pinch of salt in large bowl until stiff peaks form. Fold in marshmallow cream. Line 9"x5" loaf pan with plastic wrap. Cover bottom with graham crackers (4). Cover with 1 c pudding spreading evenly. Top with another layer of graham crackers and 1/3 of cream mixture. Repeat layers once more ending with graham crackers on top. Transfer remaining 1/3 cream mixture to small bowl. Cover cake and reserved cream with plastic wrap and refrigerate overnight. Remove cake & invert on platter. Top with reserved cream. Lightly toast mini marshmallows in oven on broil. Sprinkle over cake and serve.
